Equality Texas has been fighting to secure full and lived equality for LGBTQ+ Texans in all areas of the law for nearly 35 years. We have been committed to this work despite a hostile landscape because we have the power of our community—a community that shows up, speaks out, and pushes back no matter how hard things can be.

Since 2020, anti-LGBTQ+ extremists have pursued a nationally coordinated strategy to spread disinformation and fear about LGBTQ+ people, particularly transgender youth and adults, culminating in a cruel and sophisticated layered attack we have not seen in decades.

As we've seen in past sessions, our community continues to be targeted by representatives who are trying their best to eradicate the existence of LGBTQ+ Texans. Time and time again our supporters have shown up to demand the privacy, dignity, and respect all Texans deserve.

Every time we are knocked down, we get back up and create new plans, new ways to fight. This year we want all Texans to know that Texas has always been queer. And that won't ever change.
